Sealed bids will be received by the CITY OF COLVILLE, located at 170 S. OAK, COLVILLE, WA 99114 until **11:00 am, Thursday, April 20th 2017**, for the **COLVILLE AIRPORT TRANSMISSION MAIN PROJECT** in the City of Colville, WA.

Scope of Work: Project consists of the construction of approximately 3,000 lineal feet of 12 inch and approximately 3,000 lineal feet of 16 inch potable water main between Highway 20 and Fairway Loop Drive through the Colville Airport. Approximately 2500 lineal feet of water main will be installed in the same trench. Project includes potable water main appurtenances and surface restoration. The majority of the water mains will run parallel to or within the Airport's northwestern taxiway. Surface restoration includes placement approximately 700 cubic yards of base rock for new taxiway surface.
